

### PATRICK EVANS WILL BE GUEST ARTIST








## DECEMBER BREAKUP DAY






# PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Quite a few members came up to me at the Xmas BBQ Bash and indicated how pleased and proud they were of their club. Thank you for that.


Finally, none of this would happen without the brilliant, unified and hardworking committee that you elected. What a great team we have. Thank you for helping me and supporting me during the year.

#### **GIRGARRE 2015**






